Annual Tenant Assistance Program Helps Families Remain at Historic Ballston Park

When AHC redeveloped Historic Ballston Park with Paradigm in 1996, we created a Tenant Assistance Program to help some of the original families remain in their apartments. Since then we have partnered with Arlington County to annually subsidize rents for a number of families whose incomes are lower than the minimum requirements. The program has helped more than 20 families over the years remain at Historic Ballston Park, which includes 233 affordable apartments along Glebe Road.



Construction Continues Despite Cold

Work continues at AHC's two new construction projects in Arlington despite the record-breaking cold. The Jordan, 90 new units near Ballston, will be completed next summer. The Macedonian, 36 new apartments in Nauck, is accepting applications for May move-in dates.
