Shelton Wins Recognition; Completes Leasing

The Shelton provides 94 affordable apartments.

The Shelton has won an Honorable Mention in the Metropolitan/Urban Housing category for this year's [Charles L. Edson Tax Credit Excellence Awards](#) competition, which is coordinated by the [Affordable Housing Tax Credit Coalition](#).

The Shelton is now fully leased. AHC's Resident Services staff are offering programs to residents, including child care so parents can attend family workshops. A preschool is in the works for next fall.

Arlington Allocates AHIF Funds for The Jordan

The Jordan will include 73 two and three-bedroom apartments for families and 17 one-bedroom units.



On April 28, the Arlington County Board allocated up to \$5.58 million in new Affordable Housing Investment Fund (AHIF) funds to assist with the construction of [The Jordan Apartments](#). The 90-unit affordable apartment building is part of a joint site plan with The JBG Companies that also includes two new office towers and market-rate townhomes. The Jordan is expected to be ready for occupancy in 2011.
